



The Level 3 Vocational Programme of Study

This programme allows students to specialise in one subject area.

This pathway leaves the option of university open – but only in courses that follow a similar subject area. Students could also access apprenticeships and direct employment after sixth form. Students who access these courses should have 5 grade 4-9 at GCSE with some courses requiring English and/or Maths at a grade 5 or 6, due to the amount of written work or numeracy required.

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Post 16 Pathways

We offer a variety of pathways to students dependent on their learning style, interests and level of study.

Our pathways specifically offer recommended subjects that will lead to popular careers and employment routes. We have designed our study programmes to fit a British curriculum within the international context of the UAE.

Additional to the pathways we offer the International Project Qualification (IPQ), re-sit Maths or English, enrichment and a life skills programme across Years 12 and 13. Our pathways are designed to allow access to popular careers.

Entry Requirements

As with most post 16 providers, our courses do have entry requirements to help students select the right course. Our final curriculum offer will depend upon the number of students wishing to study a subject, as options with extremely small numbers may unfortunately have to be withdrawn.

The Academic Pathway

The academic pathway below is usually followed by students who have achieved mainly 9-6 grades in all subjects. Students on these pathways go on to apply for university after Sixth Form.

The Combined Pathway
