



To enter for this Award, please complete the following:

- (1) Including at least three departments in your school, including one drawn from the Sciences, one from the Humanities and one from the Art and/or Design Department, design your version of a Jet Pack. The brief is to “make our readers and judges gasp at the imagination of children, and the amazing ways different subject disciplines have *worked together*.” Any Department could be included in the project; you could build a jet pack or create a symphony. There is no limit; you just have to use your imagination to represent your school and its children best. Your final submission should be photographed, described/detailed/explained and you may include audio and/or video. The project should engage children between the ages of 12 to 17.
- (2) Provide a quote from the Principal, Subject Heads and Children on the project and why **STEAM** is so important in your school. Please provide captioned photographs for each.
- (3) As part of the following application, you will strengthen your case considerably by *sending the following survey links to your students, teachers and parents*, asking them to independently provide feedback on your school as part of your entry to the Top Schools Awards 2023-24.
